File Format TIF, .EPS or .PSD (layered filename are best for color correction flexibility)

Special Note:

Scanning specifications: final print size: 100 d.p.i.

- Do not increase the dpi of a 5mb to a 20mb. This doesn't add quality.
- When saving an .EPS file do not use .jpeg encoding use binary encoding.
- When saving a .TIFF file format, LZW compression may be used.
- When saving a .PSD file format, raster fonts or provide fonts and save with layers intact.

Layout Requirements: Illustrator CS 2 – do not use for gradient colors – gradient colors use only Photoshop w/ noisefilter

<u>Special Note:</u> Use Vector art whenever possible. **Outline fonts** Provide all placed images. Do not just embed them -This limits color correction
